

# Chatterbox - "Get to know you" activity

Ask your partner one of the questions - then chatterbox the answer  
 Ask your partner another question - then chatterbox the answer.  
 Show them the four symbols and get them to choose one  
 Open the chatterbox and read out the question underneath.  
 When they have answered the question you can get ready to move to your next partner.
